Summary Care Records (SCR) The SCR is an electronic record of important patient information, created from GP medical records.

Health and care staff can <u>access SCR through the</u> <u>Spine web portal</u> Patients can ask to view or add information to their SCR by visiting their GP practice.

Sharing some or all of your medical history with other health professionals can be beneficial in some circumstances, especially when being treated away from your GP practice.

You **DO** have a choice on whether or not to share this information and on how much of your health record you wish to share.
