MISSED APPOINTMENTS

We are experiencing a significant amount of DNA's (Did Not Attend) for various appointments. In particular the Practice Nurse.

We offer 20 minute appointments with the Practice Nurse for annual reviews of Diabetes, COPD, Asthma etc.

If two patients miss one appointment each, that equates to 40 minutes clinic time that could have been offered to someone else.

We are now issuing warnings to patients who repeatedly DNA. The first initial warning is issued after 3 missed appointments. The next appointment missed will warrant a final warning. If a patient misses another appointment after their final warning, they will be taken off the practice list and asked to find a new GP.

MULTIPLE PROBLEMS

Your GP appointment is for 10 minutes and for one problem only. Please try to avoid coming with multiple problems as this might take more than the time you are allocated and makes the GP late seeing other patients.

If you would like to discuss multiple problems please mention this to the receptionist and a more mutually convenient time can be arranged without impacting on clinic waiting times.
